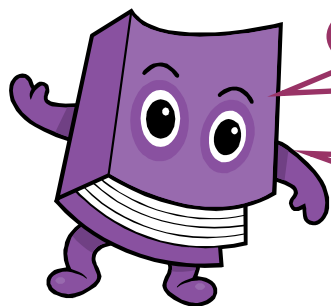
What is the “Bright Futures” project all about?
